Her classical vocal training and extensive background in jazz performance have lent themselves to Little's agile, shimmering timbre that is as comfortable in a Mozartian aria as an Ella Fitzgerald jazz standard or contemporary pop tune. She grew up heavily influenced by classic artists like The Beatles Elton John, and Carole King. These influences and experiences give her songs a unique and eclectic color not found in typical indie artists today.
